TEACHING PHILOSOPHY

1. Every Camper Matters

We care about each camper and his or her improvement. We have therefore created a curriculum to involve everyone regardless of ability.

2. “Learn Through Play” Coaching Approach

We believe that kids learn best through competitive games and activities with the focus on fun, challenge, repetition, creativity, problem solving, and motivation. We avoid static drills and the “3 L’s of Coaching”: Lines, Lectures, Laps.

3. High Expectations

Children will generally do what is expected of them. Therefore, at WCSC, our expectation is that our Mighty Mites will consistently demonstrate outstanding character.



BASIC OVERVIEW OF DAILY SCHEDULE

1. Skills & Tactical Training Sessions: The coaches use a variety of presentations, demonstrations and drills in order to break down and thoroughly teach the fundamentals of the game, our goal is to produce complete and exceptional soccer players.

2. World Cup Matches: Throughout the week each camper is assigned to a team participating in daily, small-sided World Cup matches. This gives campers the opportunity to utilize skills and tactics learned each day and also enables coaches to evaluate and teach campers in a live match situation. The week culminates on Friday with our annual **World Cup Tournament**.
